In pursuit of these objectives, and on the occasion of fifteen centuries since the birth of the Noble Prophet (PBUH), and the completion of one hundred years of academic journey of The Islamia University of Bahawalpur, the Secrat Chair of the University is organizing a grand three-days International Conference on the theme:

"Upholding Rights in the Prophet's Seerah (PBUH) and the Demands of the Contemporary Era: Intellectual Foundations, Practical Applications, and Civilizational Development."

This prestigious International Seerah Conference invites all scholars, researchers, and Ulama from Madaris Deeniah to contribute their scholarly papers on the Prophetic Seerah, in order to highlight this invaluable heritage of the Ummah. This conference will prove to be a landmark in understanding and disseminating the Seerah, and will play a significant role in the intellectual and practical advancement of the Muslim Ummah.

- 2. The interrelationship between the universe, humanity, and Fitrah
- 3. Care and compassion towards animals and plants
- 4. Benefiting from natural resources while preserving them
- 5. Development of the earth and the Islamic concept of Istikhlāf
- Sustainable development in harmony with Islamic values and the natural environment
- Prophetic guidance in addressing contemporary environmental challenges
- 8. Environmental ethics in times of peace and war

Terms & Conditions about Article submission

- The manuscripts must be in accordance with the topics of the conference.
- The manuscripts must be written according to the HEC Anti Plagiarism Policy.
- The manuscripts must follow the general rules of research & should be free from all sorts of errors.
- The manuscripts must not be submitted to any other conference or research journal.
- The Quranic verses & the Ahadith must be cited along with the original text.
- The Chicago 16th footnote style must be adopted for citation.
- The manuscript must have an abstract of about 300 words.
- The manuscript must be composed in M.S word.
- The manuscript should be 15-20 pages long.
- The manuscript must be prepared on A4 size with 1 margin on all sides. Font for Urdu should be Jameel Nori Nastaleeq, for English Times New Roman & for Arabic Traditional Arabic.
- The manuscript must be submitted in both hard & soft copy.
- The submitted manuscript will be evaluated through the Blind Peer Review process. The decision to accept or reject a manuscript rest solely with the conference committee.

The top ten national-level articles will have their registration fees refunded and will also receive an honorarium.
