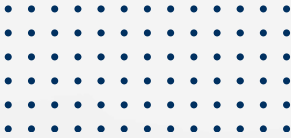

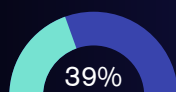

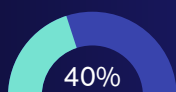


HEC RANKING CRITERIA FOR RECOGNITION AND UNIVERSITY OVERHEAD FROM FUNDED PROJECTS

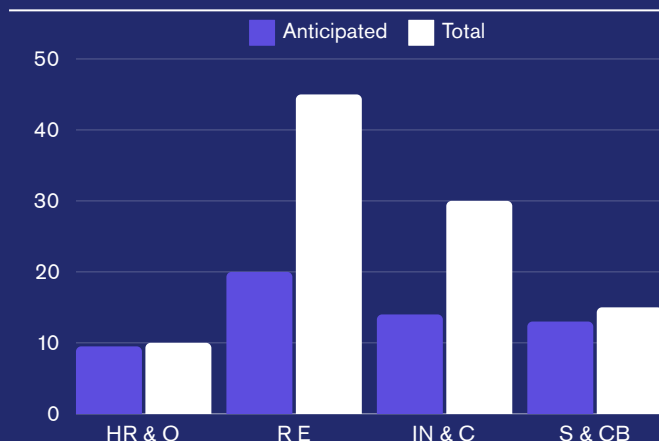

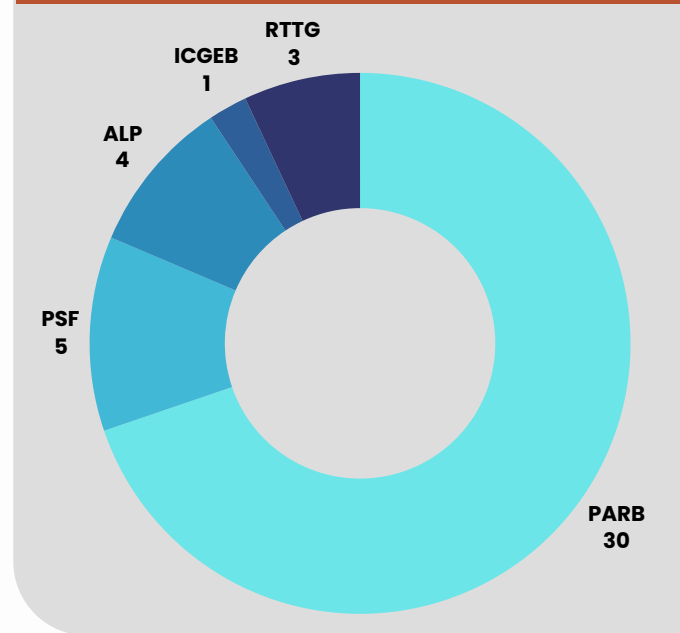
Yields from the Meetings

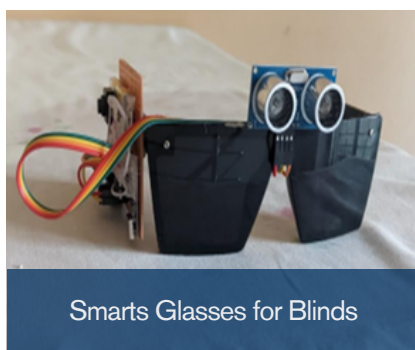
Firefighting Robot

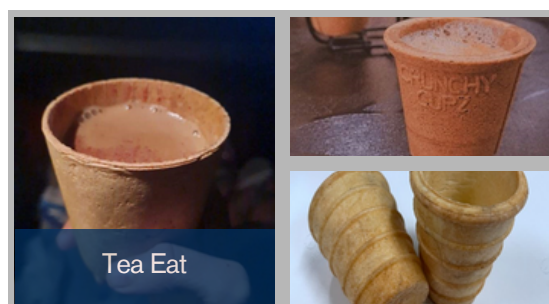
Eco-Friendly Pencil

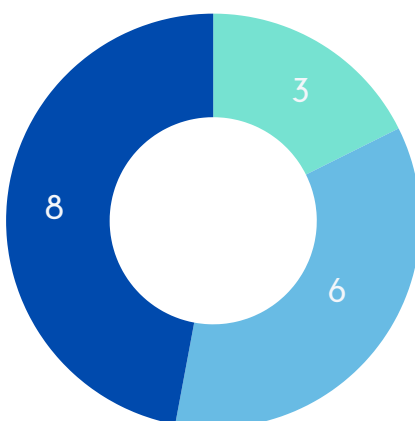


Tea Eat

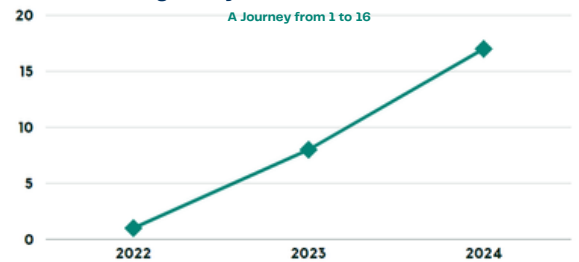

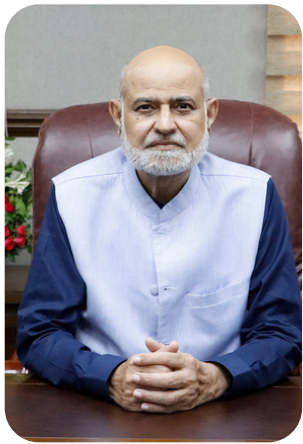
