IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ALLOTMENT IN HOSTELS

1. Commencement of Hostel Allotment for Fall 2020 Semester w.e.f: 05/10/2020

- Despite intense perplexity on account of contemporary COVID-19 pandemic threat, IUB
 has decided to allow the students to attend classes in different phases.
- b. During First Phase, several classes i.e. B.S: 1st & 8th, B.S: 2nd & 7th, M.A/M.Sc: 1st & 4th and
 M.Phil & Ph.D: 1st, 2nd & 3rd shall be allowed to acquire on-campus tutorials combined with online modules; initially for a period of 05 weeks.
- c. After successful completion of first phase, the students will leave the campus to make way for the students of second phase to attend classes physically. Similarly the third phase students will come upon the departure of students of second phase.
- d. IUB hostels have commenced issuing challan forms for hostel allotment with effect from October 05, 2020 and shall continue on daily basis until 6.00 pm until all seats are filled.
- e. The allotment shall purely be on <u>first come first serve basis</u>. The number of seats in both girls & boys hostels are scarce and hence, once all seats are filled, the allotment process shall halt automatically irrespective of left out students of above mentioned semesters.
- f. The conventional hostel quota is not being offered to the departments for this semester because all arrangements in hostels are temporary in wake of COVID-19.
- g. All continuing students shall be relocated to different hostels and rooms, keeping in view the COVID-19 safety rules.
- h. All new students seeking fresh allotment in IUB hostels are required (in person or through parents/guardians) to get their allotment forms and undertakings duly signed & stamped by Chairperson/H.O.Ds/Principals of the respective Department/College.
- i. After completing the codal formalities for allotment from the departments, the student may approach the hostel administration for eventual allotment process.
- j. Hostel dues for the Fall Semester 2020 are as under:-

For new Students	For Continuing students
Rs. $10,375.00 + 4,000.00$ (Refundable Security Deposit)	Rs. 10,175.00

* Hostel dues are required to be paid once for the entire semester. The students who depart after first phase shall not be required to pay again upon their return.

k. Female Hostels

- i. Allotment stations for new female students have been created at Zainab Hall, Baghdad ul Jadeed Campus, Bahawalpur and at Ayesha & Fatima Hall, Aamna & Khadija Hall and Rabia Hall for the continuing female students for the purpose of obtaining hostel challan form and subsequent allotment letter.

I. Male Hostels

2. Ensuring Health and Safety Protocols

- a. All hostel buildings have been prepared to ensure maximum safety for the students & staff. All precautionary measures are being taken to curb the spread of disease in IUB campuses.
- b. IUB has sanitized all hostels; especially the ones used as quarantine centers and persistently sterilizing all campuses to ensure safety of its students, teachers & employees at all campuses.
- c. The return of students in hostels is planned strictly keeping into consideration the density threshold to implement protocols with ease and ensure safety.
- d. The safety of students is prime concern of IUB Hostels. Any resident found in any condition of ailment shall be immediately isolated.
- e. Non-allotees/guests shall not be allowed in hostels.
- f. All students & hostel staff will strictly follow the instructions as under:-

- i. Mask must be worn at all times at public areas by the students and during work by staff.
- ii. Social distancing of 6 feet in the rooms, cafeterias, corridors, staircases & and all public areas must be maintained.
- iii. Hygiene practices i.e. washing hands thoroughly with soap for 20 seconds or use of a good sanitizer must be maintained.
- iv. Only designated entry/exits of hostels shall be used.
- v. The movement in hostels shall be limited.
- vi. Physical contact such as shaking hands & etc. must be avoided.
- g. Thermal guns shall be used to closely monitor all staff & students.
- h. IUB Hostels will consider the specific needs of students with disabilities as they are prone to exposure to the dangers of deadly virus.
- i. IUB Hostels will avoid indoor or outdoor co-curricular or extra-curricular activities until the return of normal conditions.
- j. Anyone committing minor or inadvertent breach may be warned of the violation of established S.O.P. Repeated violations shall be reprimanded in accordance to regulation.
